Top Corner league champions from the 2009/10 seasons rolled up at the all new surroundings of T47 (London Bridge) to contest the men's and women's 2010 Champions cup and of course bragging rights as the best of the best, for at least the next 12 months!

The day began with the women's competition. The format was a little different this year, with one group of 6 teams playing the opposition once to determine a top two, who would then contest a final! Holloway Road league winners, **Crouch End Tigers** and Kennington league runners up **The Comets** dominated the group stage. Crouch End, stormed straight to the final with maximum points and scoring 12 times along the way, which would see them finish as the joint third highest scoring team and conceding the least amount of goals of all teams playing in the men's and women's competition. The Comets were equally as impressive, losing 3-2, only once, to the group winners Crouch End, whilst bagging 11 en route to the final. The runners up in the group were Southwark based **London 2012 Ladies**, Southwark women's champs **FSA WFC**, London Bridge regulars **Heroines of Waterloo** and Kennington champions **Brixton Tigers**.

The final between the equally impressive teams was a tight affair, although The Comets took a 2-0 lead, however with a few minutes remaining on the clock, Crouch End struck back to make it a tense final few minutes, there were chances either end to consolidate and equalise, Nevertheless, it was the Comets who held on and after three blasts of the referees whistle were crowned Women's Top Corner Champions Cup 2010 champions!

The men's half of the competition began immediately after the Women's awards presentation, the format for the men's competition was again a little different this year, with the team finishing top of their respective group advancing to a semi final, subsequently two teams advancing to the final.

Group D had been contested earlier in the day. London Legal runners up **Team Ice Cream** topped the group on goal difference after being pushed all the way by a confident team **Renaissance**, qualifiers from Tufnell Park. As both teams ended on an identical 3 wins 1 draw and no losses, it was a superior goal difference of +11 goals that decided it for Team Ice Cream, finishing as the highest scoring team in the group stages of the competition with no less than 16 in 4 games.

Group A kicked off alongside B and C in the afternoon. Finsbury Park champs, **Olympique Finsbury** won group A finishing on 10 points, with Battersea Wednesday's **Chelsea Old Boys** pipped to the post, after having lost 3-2 in a tightly fought game against Olympique, thus lining up a meeting in the semis with the winner of Group C. Meanwhile in Group B, defending champions **Bertrams** were making their way up the table, with a couple of hiccups on the way, Islington Monday's **Stallas** went close in causing an upset with a 1-1 draw, whilst Waterloo Wednesday team **Glyn Park Rangers** also knicked a point with another 1-1 draw. However, Bertrams proved to be the strongest team, winning the rest of their games, finishing on 11 points and heading to the semis with Group D winners Team Ice Cream.

In Group C, Turnham Green champs **Club Neverathon** finished top of the pile. An impressive 15 goals and 4 wins out of 5 confirmed that they were well in charge, although Waterloo Tuesday runners up **Slightly Athletic** pushed all the way, but a suffered a loss early on to Design League champions **Ted Baker Lobstars**, which proved pivotal. So, Club Neverathon were up against Olympique Finsbury in the second semi final!

Both semis kicked off at the same time, with a well rested Team Ice Cream taking on a Bertrams team riding high in confidence, they had been here a year earlier and were in no mood to drop out now! Bertrams settled into their usual passing momentum and took the game to Team Ice Cream. Bertrams bagged 5 goals, with just one in consolation from Team Ice Cream; you could hear the cheers on the other side of London Bridge!! Bertrams were in the final for the second year in a row!

The second semi final, proved to be one of the games of the tournament, Olympique Finsbury took the lead with a thunderous strike to go one up, after clearly being the better team in the opening stages. It looked all set for Olympique to go through, however nobody had read Club Neverthons version of the story! Two quick strikes on the break, saw Club Neverathon take a surprise lead and left Olympique stunned, only heroics from both keepers kept the score as it was, a look of disbelief swept across Olympique faces, watching Club Neverathon players punch the air in delight, the final whistle had gone and Olympique had blown it!

So it was to be the regning champions Bertrams taking on the best of west London Club Neverathon. Both teams were given a 5 minute break before the final got under way, a perfect opportunity to discuss tactics and take on some water. A crowd gathered around the pitch to see who would walk off it as champions, a round of cheers and applause erupted from pitch side fans of both teams as the ref got the match underway. Bertrams once again staged the game by the scruff of the neck and smashed in an early goal, Club Neverathon heads dropped and despite a very commendable performance, conceded two more to a Bertrams team clearly wanting to put on a show, the ref looked at his watch and signalled the end of the game shortly after the third goal went in, Bertrams fans ran onto the pitch to celebrate with the players, with the sound of 'campeones ole, ole, ole' resounding through the T47 tunnels!

Congratulations to individual award winners, Crouch End Tiger's Helen Clarke and The Comet's Alma Donohoe, who finished joint top goal scorers in the women's competition, with Alma also winning player of the tournament. Bertrams' Graham Carr finished top goal scorer in the men's competition whilst, Team Ice Cream's Tom Martin won the player of the tournament.

The remainder of runners up at group stage were as follows, Group A, **Winkreative, Twisted Mullets** and **Bloomberg**. Group B, were, **AFC Super Hans, Glyn Park Rangers, Stallas** and **Dale Evans Lions**. Group C were, **Ted Baker Lobstars, The In Firm, Not@Allstars**, and **Askew Angels**. Finally in Group D, **Peabody FC, The Monks** and **Club Stormy**.

A massive well done for qualifying for this years champions cup to all teams involved, it was a great day with a lot of highlights! We look forward to seeing all qualifiers in 2011, could Bertrams be back for a famous hat-trick!?
